
At the same meeting the women found out they were to submit to their husbands as they would submit to Jesus Christ.

Carvajal which is four hours from Limbe. **There were 101 leaders present with**

40 women and 61 men. We have started including women because there is so little teaching for them and to only include half of the family makes it an incomplete attempt in making the family whole. Once again literature was so much appreciated. Three hundred fifty pieces of literature in Creole were given out. Literature in French is hard to read and they love this Creole material. Science Fair

The science fair entries of the older students in the Grace Academy were outstanding. There were projects on corn planted on different soils, water purification, and how to make a water filter. Earthquake research was done by putting boards



together with marbles in between, ants, crickets, the history of phones.

was on how well they explained the project, their knowledge of the subject, the amount of research that had been done, content of the written report, and many more. We are very proud of the progress the kids are making in school.



Consulting Room Needed

Last month we started telling you about the need for a consulting room for Doctor Sara to see women who are pregnant and those who come for help in their surrounding village. It does not work well to have these women coming into their house. **The need for privacy is apparent.**

We believe this could be a great help to the area to have a doctor available to them but also to the



progress of the ministry. **The cost of this room will be \$3,000. So far we have received \$500.** Carlos will do most of the work. It will be located inside the compound walls but have a door that will be accessed from the outside without interrupting their home life.
