Everybody starts a new year with challenges and goals that they hope to accomplish. We started a new year continuing to build the body of our Lord Jesus Christ, but also remodeling and building the bathrooms for the Home Church. We have faced different difficulties in the process but thanks to our Lord we have got over them. However, the bathrooms project is taking us a little bit longer that we expected.
